Undergrowth, rhododendron, chinquapin, manzanita and vinemaple.

79.94 Intersect the N. and S. line, 37 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27.

Thence,

N.89\*50'W., on a true line bet. secs. 22 and 27.

Over mountainous land, through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

Ascend 655 ft. over SE. slope.
