65.90	Ridge spur, slopes NE. Descend 340 ft. over NW. slope,
79.94	The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28. Land, mountainous. Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam, 3rd rate. Timber, fir, pine, cedar and hemlock. Undergrowth, rhododendron, chinquapin and salal.
