A pine, 40 ins. in diam., bears N.68\*E., 81 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 2 E S 15 B T

A fir, 26 ins. in diam., bears S.60 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*E., 39 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 2 E S 22 B T

A fir, 36 ins. in diam., bears S.61\*W., 27 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 2 E S 21 B T

A fir, 42 ins. in diam., bears N.60 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*W., 24 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 2 E S 16 B T

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, cedar and hemlock.

Undergrowth, snowbrush, willow, soapbrush, rhododendron, chinquapin and vinemaple.

S.89\*50'E., on a random line bet. secs. 15 and 22.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor.

80.40 Intersect the cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23.

Thence,

N.89\*50'., on a true line bet. secs. 15 and 22.

Over mountainous land, through dense undergrowth in old burned over area.

Descend 95 ft. over SW. slope.

5.90 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SE.

Ascend 250 ft. over SE. slope.

12.40 Spur, slopes SE.

Descend 300 ft. over broken SW. slope.

31.40 Enter timber, bears N. and S.

35.15 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SW.

Ascend 135 ft. over SE. slope.

39.60 Spur, slopes SE.
