	Land, mountainous. Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam; 3rd rate. Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Pine, Cedar and Yew. Undergrowth, Vinemaple, Chinquapin and Rhododendron.
	N.89*51'E., on a random line bet. Secs. 21 and 28.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner.
80.06	Intersect the N and S line, 12 lks. N of the corner of Secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28.
	Thence
	S.89*56'W., on a true line bet. Secs. 21 and 28.
	Over mountainous land, through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.
	Ascend 245 ft. over broken NE slope.
5.60	Small spur, slopes N.
11.40	Spur, slopes NW.
	Descend 525 ft. over broken NW slope.
17.95	Small spring on line, course NW.
30.30	Draw, course N.
	Ascend 165 ft. over NE slope.
36.20	Spur, slopes NW.
	Descend 100 ft. over W slope.
40.03	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor., with brass cap marked
