80.06	The cor. of Secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29. Land, mountainous. Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam, 3rd rate. Timber, Fir, Pine, Hemlock and Yew. Undergrowth, Rhododendron, Chinquapin, Manzanita and Vinemaple.
