A fir, 24 ins. in diam., bears S.39*W., 106 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 2 E S 8 B T

A fir, 22 ins. in diam., bears N.44*W., 42 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 2 E S 5 B T

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock and pine.

Undergrowth, rhododendron, chinquapin and vinemaple.

N.89*52'E., on a random line bet. secs. 4 and 9.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

79.78 Intersect the N. and S. line, 23 lks. N. of the cor. of
secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.
