CHAINS	Ascend 185 ft. over NE. slope.
50.10	Draw, course NE. Ascend 365 ft. over series of bluffs on NE. slope.
67.50	Deception Creek Way Trail, bears NE. and SW.
67.60	Spur, slopes NW. Descend 335 ft. over broken W. slope.
75.10	Top of rock cliff, 80 ft. high, bears NW. and SE., faces SW.
79.78	The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, Land, mountainous. Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam, 3rd rate. Timber, fir, hemlock, pine, cedar and yew. Undergrowth, vinemaple, rhododendron and chinquapin.
	N.0°03'W., on a random line bet. secs.4 and 5.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.36	Intersect the N. bdy. of the Tp., 9 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, hereinbefore described. Thence, S.0°07'E., on a true line bet. secs.4 and 5. Over mountainous land, through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth. Ascend 550 ft. over broken NE. slope.
4.60	Small spur, slopes NE.
16.00	Small spur, slopes E. Descend 30 ft. over SE. slope.
20.70	Draw, course NE. Ascend 180 ft. over N. slope.
36.10	Spur, slopes NE. Ascend 65 ft. over NE. slope.
40.36	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
