79.63 Intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp., 19 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, which is an iron post, 2 ins. in diam., protruding 9 ins. above ground, with brass cap marked

A fir, 26 ins. in diam., bears N.49*E., 80 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 2 E S 18 B T

A fir, 12 ins. in diam., bears S.74*E., 27 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 2 E S 19 B T

A fir, 8 ins. in diam., bears S.11 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 13 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 1 E S 24 B T

A fir, 22 ins. in diam., bears N.52 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 49 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 1 E S 13 B T

Thence,

N.89*44'E., on a true line bet. secs. 18 and 19.

Over mountainous land, through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

Ascend 75 ft. over W. slope.

7.10 Spur, slopes NW.

Descend 255 ft. over broken NE. slope.

18.65 Small spur, slopes NW.

26.85 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course N.

29.70 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course NW.

Ascend 255 ft. over W. slope.
