GENERAL DESCRIPTION - Cont'd

Wallows located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 32, at Lost Spring in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25, and Twin Lakes Camp, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 9.

The camp at Twin Lakes is one of nature's beauty spots. The larger of the lakes covers about 19 acres and the smaller one about 12 acres. There are several springs of ice cold water flowing into these lakes but in the summer the water in the lakes is about blood heat. Fish have been planted in the lakes several times but they do not seem to do very well, there are a few fish left but their meat is rather soft and they do not seem to have much life.

Twin Lakes Bluff is about 400 ft. high, located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 16, overlooking the lakes and affording one of nature's wonder views from its top. This bluff is reached by trail from the Ranger Station on top of Twin Lakes Mountain.

The average mean magnetic declination is $22\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E.
