Heavily timbered hemlock, fir, and pine.
Thick underbrush of fir, laurel and vine maple.

East, on S. boundary of sec. 35. Var. 18°30'E.

30.00 Enter small prairie.

39.50 Leave prairie and enter timber.

40.00 Set post, 44x4 ins. firmly in the ground for stand. $\frac{1}{4}$
sec. cor. marked S C on N. and S. faces.

from which,

A hemlock, 18 ins. in dia., bears S.30°E., 11 lks. dist.,
marked S C $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T

A hemlock, 12 ins. in dia., bears S.18°W., 23 lks. dist.,
marked S C $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T

80.00 Set post, 50x4 ins. firmly in the ground for stand. cor.
to secs. 35 and 36. marked S C T 27 S R 3 E on N. sec.
36 on E. and S 35 on W. faces with 1 notch on E. and
5 on W. edges,

from which,

A fir, 42 ins. in dia., bears N.22°E., 21 lks. dist.,
marked T 27 S R 3 E S 36 B T

A fir, 18 ins. in dia., bears N.53°W., 46 lks. dist.,
marked T 27 S R 3 E S 35 B T

A fir, 16 ins. in dia., bears S.40°E., 18 lks. dist.,
marked S B T

Land, 4th rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock and pine of good quality.

Thick underbrush of fir, and vine maple.

High and mountainous.

July 5, 1883.

East, on S. boundary of sec. 36 Var. 18°E.

12.00 Summit of spur.

Descend mountain.
