A fir, 6 ins. in dia., bears S.33\*E., 22 lks. dist.,  
marked T 27 S R 4 E S 31 B T

A hemlock, 10 ins. in dia., bears S.27\*W., 11 lks. dist.,  
marked T 27 S R 3 E S 36 B T

A hemlock, 20 ins. in dia., bears N.59\*W., 12 lks. dist.,  
marked T 27 S R 3 E S 25 B T

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy, gravelly and rocky, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, hemlock and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple, huckleberry, small fir, pine,  
and hemlock.

North, bet. secs. 25 and 30.

Ascend 15 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber and  
medium undergrowth.

3.00 Spur, bears E., descend 35 ft. over NE. slope.

8.70 Draw, drains E., ascend 85 ft. over SE. slope.

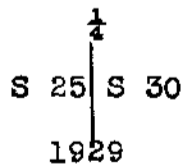
14.50 Spur, bears E., descend 30 ft. over NE. slope.

18.50 Draw, drains E., ascend 55 ft. over SE. slope.

23.50 Spur, bears E., descend 50 ft. over NE. slope.

37.22 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course NE. ascend 20 ft.  
over SE. slope to.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 30 ins. in  
the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked.
