CHAINS

A pine, 8 ins. in dia., bears N.43*W., 17 lks. dist.,
marked T 27 S R 3 E S 12 B T

Land, mountainous and rolling.

Soil, sandy and gravelly, 1st and 2nd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, hemlock and larch.

Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, buck brush, thorn,
small fir, pine and hemlock.

North, bet. secs. 7 and 12.

Ascend 35 ft. over rolling SW. slope to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.,
through stunted timber and dense undergrowth.

36.65 Trail, bears E. and W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 30 ins. in
the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked.

marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 12 B T

Ascend 45 ft. over rolling SW. slope to sec. cor.

43.75 Big Camas to Diamond Lake road, bears E. and W. The
timber gradually becomes heavy.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 30 ins. in
the ground, for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with
brass cap marked.
