

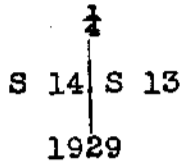

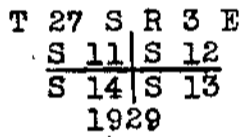

A fir, 16 ins. in dia., bears S.49*W., 48 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 3 E S 14 B T

A fir, 24 ins. in dia., bears N.84 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 115 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 3 E S 11 B T
