A fir, 22 ins. in dia., bears S.71\*E., 45 lks. dist.,

marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 34 B T

A fir, 24 ins. in dia., bears N.9\*W., 36 lks. dist.,

marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 33 B T

Descend 400 ft. over broken NW. slope to sec. cor.
