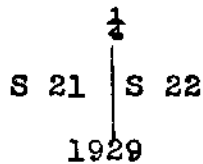

A fir, 24 ins. in dia., bears N.15\*E., 31 lks. dist.,  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 22 B T

A hemlock, 14 ins. in dia., bears N.71\*W., 16 lks. dist.,  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 21 B T

Descend 80 ft. over NW. slope.

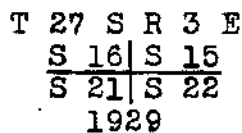
42.66 Creek, 7 lks. wide, course NE., ascend 125 ft. over SE.  
slope.

56.30 Spur, bears NE., descend 170 ft. over NW. slope.

71.58 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NE., ascend 75 ft. over SE.  
slope to sec. cor.

74.80 Trail, bears NE. and SW.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 26 ins. in  
the ground, for cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22,  
with brass cap marked.

A hemlock, 14 ins. in dia., bears N.54 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*E., 94 lks. dist.,  
marked T 27 S R 3 E S 15 B T

A pine, 8 ins. in dia., bears S.37 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*E., 81 lks. dist.,  
marked T 27 S R 3 E S 22 B T

A pine, 36 ins. in dia., bears S.49\*W., 9 lks. dist.,  
marked T 27 S R 3 E S 21 B T

A fir, 16 ins. in dia., bears N.30\*W., 42 lks. dist.,  
marked T 27 S R 3 E S 16 B T

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy, gravelly, and rocky, 2nd to 4th rate.

Timber, fir, pine and hemlock.

Undergrowth, rhododendron, huckleberry, hazel, vine  
maple, small fir, pine and hemlock.
