

West boundary of T. 27 S., R. 6 E.

CHAINS

A pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S.5°E., 17 lks. dist.

Marked T 27 S R 6 E S 6 B T.

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S.83°W., 9 lks. dist.

Marked T 27 S R 5 E S 1 B T.

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N.89°W., 36 lks. dist.

Marked T 26 S R 5 E S 36 B T.

Land rough and mountainous. Densely covered with forests of pine and fir timber and thick pine and fir underbrush.

Soil, fourth rate.

North Boundary of T. 27 S., R. 6 E.
Same Deputy and Contract.

From the cor. to Tps. 26 and 27 S., R. 5 and 6 E., I run East on random line between said townships, (the variation of my compass being 18°E.) I set temporary half mile and mile corners at each 40 and 80 chains and find the township line to be 6 miles, 36 lks. and the falling to be 42 lks. N. of the cor. to Tps. 26 and 27 S., Rs. 6 and 6½ E. The correction for the true line will therefore be 7 lks. south and 36 lks. East per mile, and its course N.89°57'W.

From the cor. to Tps. 26 and 27 S., R. 6 and 6½ E., which is a post 4 ins. sqr. firmly set in the ground and marked T 26 S S 31 on NE., R6½ E S 6 on SE., T 27 S S 1 on SW. and R 6 E S 36 on NW. faces with 6 notches on N., S., E., and W. edges. Thence I run N.89°51'W., on true line bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Var. 18°30'E.

Dry ravine, course NW.
