Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. and at

Intersect East boundary of township, 60 lks. N. of cor. to secs. 29, 32, 31 and 25, which is a post 4 ins. sqr., firmly set in ground, marked T 27 S S 29 on NE., R  $6\frac{1}{2}$  E S 32 on SE., R 6 E S 36 on SW., and S 25 on NW. faces, with 1 notch on the S. and 5 on N. edges, from which

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N.40\*E., 35 lks. dist.

Marked T 27 S R  $6\frac{1}{2}$  E S 29 B T.

A pine, 24 ins. diam., bears S.45\*E., 130 lks. dist.

Marked T 27 S R  $6\frac{1}{2}$  E Sec. 32 B T.

A pine, 16 ins. diam., bears S.65\*W., 170 lks. dist.

Marked T 27 S R 6 E S 36 B T.

A pine, 24 ins. diam., bears N.85\*W., 120 lks. dist.

Marked T 27 S R 6 E S 25 B T.

Thence I run N.89\*34'W., with same var. on true line bet. secs. 25 and 36.

Set post. 44x4 ins. sqr., 12 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on N. face, from which

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.28\*W., 7 lks. dist.

Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.87\*W., 16 lks. dist.

Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  post was set on west slope of mountain.

Descend steep mountain.

The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.

Land, high and mountainous, 1000 feet above last sec. cor. and covered with dense forests of pine and fir timber.
