N. edges, from which

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.50*E., 15 lks. dist.

Marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S 20 B T.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.41*E., 4 lks. dist.

Marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S 29 B T.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.80*W., 10 lks. dist.

Marked T 27 S R 6 E S 25 B T.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.72*W., 44 lks. dist.

Marked T 27 S R 6 E S 24 B T.

Thence I run N.89*58'W., with same var. on true line bet. secs. 24 and 25. Descending.
