	East, on random line bet. secs. 27 and 34. Var. 19°30'E.
40.00	Set temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. and at
79.90	Intersect N. and S. line at post to cor. of secs. 26, 35, 34 and 27. Thence I run west on true line with same var. between secs. 27 and 34.
39.95	Set post 44x4 ins. sqr., 12 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on North face, from which A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.89°W., 7 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S.25°E., 14 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
	Ascend mountain.
79.90	The corner to secs. 27, 28, 33, and 34. Land, rough and mountainous, covered with dense forests of pine and fir timber. Thick underbrush of same kind of woods. Soil, 3rd. rate. September 11th. 1883.
	North, on line bet. secs. 27 and 28. Var. 19°E.
	Descend mountain.
11.25	Dry ravine, course E. and W.
40.00	Set post 44x4 ins. sqr., 12 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face, from which A pine, 5 ins. diam., bears S.50°E., 4 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S.61°W., 5 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
57.15	Stream, 5 lks. wide, course NW.
71.25	Bottom of ravine, course NE. and SW.
80.00	Set post 50x4 ins. sqr., 20 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 22, 27, 28 and 21, marked T 27 S S 22 on NE.
