 A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears S.5*E., 7 lks. dist.

 A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.75*W., 5 lks. dist.
 Marked T 27 S R 6 E S 28 B T.
 A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.55*W., 9 lks. dist.
