GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The whole of this township is mountainous, lying on the East slope of the Cascade Range of mountains: and is covered with a fine growth of yellow pine and red fir timber.

The southern part is well watered by clear cold mountain streams, but the northern part is exceedingly dry, and not very suitable for settlements.
