Then we went to cor. of secs. 7 and 18 on W. bdy. of T 28 S and run a random line N. to complete the unsurveyed W. bdy. of secs. 6 &amp; 7.</p> <p>For notes of said survey see pages 51 and 52.</p> <p>Our standard line intersects W. bdy. of sec. 6 at 5 miles 11 chs. 60 lks., and at a point 69 chs. 89 lks., S. from cor. to Tps. 27 &amp; 28 S Rs <math>6\frac{1}{2}</math> &amp; 7 E.
