A pine, 16 ins. diam., bears S.55\*W., 44 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  E S 24 B T

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N.55\*W., 15 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  E S 13 B T

A pine, 14 ins. diam., bears N.70\*E., 12 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 7 3 S 19 B T

Thence I run S.89\*49'W. with same var. on true line  
bet. secs. 13 and 24.

39.95 Set post, 44 ins. by 4 ins. sq. 12 ins. in the ground, for

$\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on N. face, from which :

A pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S.25\*W., 6 lks.

dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T

A pine, 8 ins. diam., bears N.66\*E., 24 lks.

dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T

53.00 Stream, 2 lks. wide, course NE.

Ascend hill.

79.90 The cor. to Secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24.

Land rough and hilly.

Soil 2nd rate. Covered with dense forests of pine and  
fir timber.

Underbrush fir and pine not very thick.

North bet. Secs. 34 and 35.

From the Stan. cor. to secs. 34 and 35 which is a post  
48 ins. by 4 ins. sq., marked S C T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  E on N.  
Sec. 35 on E. and S 34 on W. faces, with 2 notches on  
E. and 3 on W. edges, from which:

A pine, 16 ins. diam., bears N.52\*E., 15 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  E S 35 B T

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N.30\*W., 18 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  E S 34 B T

A pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S.20\*W., 18 lks.

dist., marked S B T
