dist., marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  E S 23 B T

A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears S.6\*W., 27 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  E S 22 B T

A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears N.60\*W., 11 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  E S 15 B T

Land mountainous and rough, covered with dense forests of pine, fir and hemlock timber,

Thick underbrush of same kinds of wood.

Soil 3rd. rate.

Aug. 28, 1883.

East, on random line bet. secs. 14 and 23. Va. 18\* E. Descending.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

80.03 Intersect N. and S. line, 3 lks N. of cor. to secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24.

Thence I ran N.89\*59\*W. on true line with same var. bet. secs. 14 and 23.

15.53 Commencing to ascend hill.

40.01 Set post, 44 ins. by 4 ins. sq. 12 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. on N. face, from which:

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N.75\*E., 16 lks.,

dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T

A pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S.45\*W., 23 lks.

dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T

Still ascending hill

80.03 Cor. to secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23.

Land high and mountainous.

Densely covered with forests of pine, fir and hemlock timber and thick underbrush of same kinds of wood.
