	East, on random line bet. secs. 27 & 34. Va. 16*45'E.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.23	Intersect N. & S. line, 3 lks. S. of cor. to secs. 26, 27 34 and 35. Thence I run S.89*59'W. with same var. on true line bet. secs. 27 and 34. Ascending
40.12	Set post, 44 ins. by 4 ins. sq. 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. face, from which: A pine, 7 ins. diam., bears S.5*E., 11 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T A pine, 8 ins. diam., bears N.20*W., 45 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
80.23	The corner to secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34. Land mountainous, covered with dense forests of fir, pine, hemlock timber. Thick underbrush of pine and fir. Soil 3rd. rate. Aug. 29, 1883.
	North on line bet. secs. 27 & 28. Va. 16*45'E.
	Descend Hill
40.00	Set post, 44 ins. by 4 ins. sq. 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face, from which: A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.70*E., 34 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.62*W., 6 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
42.75	Dry Ravine
45.50	Summit of rige, course E. and W.
53.00	Bottom of ravine. course E. and W.
70.00	Summit of ridge, course E. and W.
