dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T

A pine, 20 ins. diam., bears S.50*W., 40 lks.

dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T

76.00 Summit of hill.

80.00 Set post, 50 ins. by 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground,,
for cor. to secs. 15,16,21,22, marked T 27 S S 15 on
NE. R6 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S 22 on SE.-, S21 on SW. and S 16 on NW.
faces, with 3 notches on S. and E. edges, from which:

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.43*E., 29 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S 15 B T

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.70*E., 24 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S 22 B T

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.30*W., 18 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S 21 B T

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.47*W., 24 lks.

dist., marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S 16 B T

Land high and mountainous.

Covered with dense forests of pine and fir timber

Some underbrush of same kinds of wood.

Soil 3rd. rate.
