A pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S.65*W., 65 lks.
dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears N.30*E., 27 lks.
dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T

Commence to descend hill.

79.75 The cor. to secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.

Land rough and mountainous, and covered with a dense

92.30 Intersect N. and S. line, 30 lks. S. of cor. to secs.
29, 32, 25 and 36, which is; a post 4 ins. sq. marked
T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S 29 on NE. S 32 on SE. R 6 E S 36 on
SW. and S 25 on NW. faces, with 1 notch on S. and 5
on N. edges, from which:
A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N.40*E., 35 lks.
dist., marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S 29 B T
A pine, 24 ins. diam., bears S.45*E., 130 lks.
dist., marked T 27 S R 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S 32 B T
A pine, 16 ins. diam., bears S.65*W., 170 lks.
dist., marked T 27 S R 6 E S 36 B T
A pine, 24 ins. diam., bears N.85*W., 120 lks.
dist., marked T 27 S R 6 E S 25 B T
