54.80	Rocky bluff, on S. slope of hill.
92.30	The cor. to sec. 28, 29, 32 and 33. This mile is very rough, rocky and mountainous. The E. half is covered with dense forests of pine and fir. Thick underbrush, on the W. half the underbrush is scattering fir and pine. Soil 4th rate.
