A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.5*E., 106 lks. dist.,
mkd. S B T.

Land, 4th rate, mountainous, rough and rocky.

Timber, fir, hemlock and pine.

Thick underbrush of vine maple, pine and fir.

Va. 21*E.

East, on S. bdy. of sec. 34.

Ascend along ridge, covered with snow, nearly NE. from a
mountain known as "Old Bailey"; supposed to be from $1\frac{1}{2}$

to secs. 34 and 35, mkd. S C T 27 S R 5 E on N, S 35
on E, and S 34 on W, faces, with 2 notches on E. and 4
on W. edges, from which.
