dist. marked T 29 S R 1 E S 1 B T.

A Chinquapin, 9 ins. diam., bears S.55*W., 46 lks.
dist. marked T 29 S R 1 E S 2 B T.

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.40*W., 35 lks.
dist. marked T 28 S R 1 E S 35 B T.

Land, mountainous, and level.

Soil, in river bottom, alluvial, 1st rate; remainder,
clay loam, 2nd and 3d rate.

Timber, Fir, Cedar, and Pine.

Undergrowth, Chinquapin, Vine Maple, Fir, Hazel.

West, bet. secs. 2 and 35.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense
undergrowth.

Ascend 75 ft. on E. slope.

4.80 Ridge, divide bet. Quartz Creek and South Umpqua River,
bears SE. and W.; descend 55 ft. on ridge.

12.65 Leave ridge, bears NW.; thence over S. slope.
