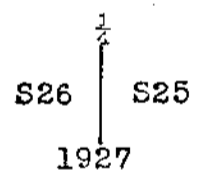

- 73.30 Branch, 10 lks. wide, course S. 10* E.; asc. 185 ft. over NE. slope.
- 79.52 The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.
Land, mountainous.
Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam; 3rd rate.
Timber, fir, pine, cedar and hemlock.
Undergrowth, vine maple, laurel and rhododendron.

N. 0* 1' W., bet. secs. 25 and 26.
Desc. 130 ft. over NE. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

- 4.70 Branch, 10 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 490 ft. over SW. slope.
- 35.00 Spur, slopes SE.; thence over E. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
