Timber, fir, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple and rhododendron.

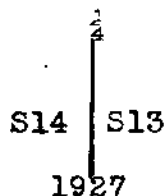
N. 0\* 1' W., bet. secs. 13 and 14.

Asc. 220 ft. over SE. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

4.00 Spur, slopes S.75\* E.; desc. 585 ft. over NE. slope.

28.35 Branch, 10 lks. wide, course S. 80\* E.; asc. 485 ft. over S. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap, mkd.

A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears S. 5\* E., 19 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S13 BT.

A cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 82\* W., 36 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S14 BT.

Asc. 105 ft. over S. slope.

43.75 Spur, slopes S. 60\* E.; desc. 50 ft. over NE. slope.

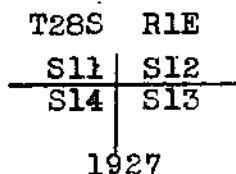
46.40 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course SE.; asc. 170 ft. over S. slope.

51.00 Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 330 ft. over NE. slope.

69.15 Ravine, course E.; asc. 175 ft. over S. slope.

76.65 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 145 ft. over NE. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, with brass cap, mkd.
