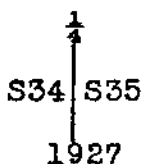


County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears S. $58\frac{1}{2}^*$ E., 35 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S35 BT.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 25^* W., 27 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S34 BT.

Asc. 160 ft. over SW. slope.

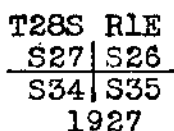
49.00 Spur, slopes SE.; asc. 65 ft. over SE. slope.

57.00 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 110 ft. over NE. slope.

63.30 Ravine, course SE.; asc. 205 ft. over SW. slope.

78.65 Spur, slopes N. 75^* E.; desc. 10 ft. over NW. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 22^* E., 47 lks. dist., mkd. T28S R1E S26 BT.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $36\frac{1}{2}^*$ E., 40 lks. dist., mkd. T28S R1E S35 BT.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. $11\frac{1}{2}^*$ W., 103 lks. dist., mkd. T28S R1E S34 BT.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 88^* W., 37 lks. dist., mkd. T28S R1E S27 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam; 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, cedar and madrona.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron and chinquapin.
