CHAINS

East, on a random line bet. secs. 26 and 35.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

79.70 Intersect N. and S. line, 40 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.

Thence

S. 89° 43' W., on a true line bet. secs. 26 and 35.

Asc. 415 ft. over broken NE. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

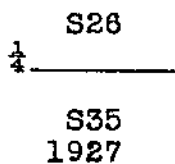
24.40 Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 50 ft. over NW. slope.

26.40 Ravine, course NE.; asc. 110 ft. over NE. slope.

29.70 Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 50 ft. over NW. slope.

33.25 Branch, 3 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 230 ft. over NE. slope.

39.85 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



from which

A pine, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 80° W., 80 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S26 BT.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 19° E., 45 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S35 BT.

Asc. 570 ft. over NE. slope.

69.70 Spur, slopes S. 60° E.; thence over S. slope.

75.70 Same spur, slopes NE.; desc. 10 ft. over NW. slope.

79.70 The cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky, loam; 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron and chinquapin.

N. 0° 2' W., bet secs. 26 and 27.

Desc. 200 ft. over NW. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.
