CHAINS

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam; third rate.

Timber, pine, fir, cedar and yew.

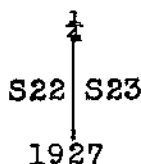
Undergrowth, rhododendron and vine maple.

N. 0° 2' W., bet. secs. 22 and 23.

Asc. 315 ft. over SW. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

21.30 Spur, slopes SE.; descend 290 feet over NE. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.19°E., 46 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S23 BT.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.36°W., 31 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S22 BT.

Desc. 30 ft. over NE. slope.

41.75 Branch, 2 lks. wide, Course E.; asc. 115 ft. over SE. slope.

47.00 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 50 ft. over NE. slope.

53.50 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course E.; ascend 260 ft. over SE. slope.

74.75 Spur, slopes SE.; descend 30 ft. over NE. slope.

77.25 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course E.; ascend 110 ft. over spur, slopes S.
