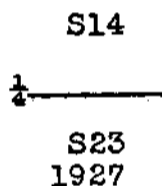
Ascend 245 feet over SE. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

10.00 Spur, slopes S.; descend 30 feet over SW. slope.

15.50 Ravine, course SE.; ascend 300 feet over SE. slope.

30.30 Spur, slopes SE.; descend 240 feet over SW. slope.

40.01 Set an iron post, 3 feet long, 1 inch diam., 27 inches in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner, with brass cap marked

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.24*W., 41 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S23 BT.

55.50 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course S.; ascend 220 ft. over SW. slope.
