Spur, slopes S.; desc. 35 ft. over SW. slope.

75.00 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 125 ft. over SE. slope.

80.02 The cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam; 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, rhododendron, vine maple and chinquapin.

N. 0° 2' W., bet. secs. 14 and 15.

Asc. spur, slopes S.; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

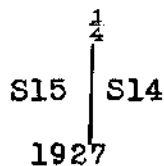
16.00 Leave spur, slopes S. from NW.; asc. SE. slope.

23.55 Tiller to Quartz Mountain Trail, bears E. and W.

25.60 Boulder Creek Way Trail, bears E. and W.

28.00 Spur, slopes SE.; 550 ft. above the sec. cor.; asc. 140 ft. over SE. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap, mkd.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 62° E., 10 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S14 BT.

A pine, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 62° W., 46 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S15 BT.

Asc. 50 ft. over SE. slope.

53.00 Divide bet. Quartz and Boulder Creeks, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 440 ft. over NW. slope.

78.80 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course W.; asc. 30 ft. over SW. slope.

80.00 Spur, slopes SW.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15,
