60.00 Spur, slopes SE.; asc. 50 ft. over SE. slope to divide.

62.70 Tiller to Quartz Mountain Trail, bears N. and S.

64.20 Divide bet. Quartz and Boulder Creeks, bears N. and S.;
desc. 285 ft. over NW. slope.

71.60 Ravine, course SW.; desc. 260 ft. over SW. slope.

79.70 The cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam; 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, cedar and hemlock.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron, chinquapin,
manzanita and hazel.

N. 0* 2' W., bet. secs. 10 and 11.

Desc. 55 ft. over NW. slope; through heavy green
timber and dense undergrowth.

7.30 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 365 ft. over NW. slope.

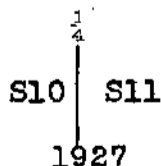
25.50 Ravine, course W.; asc. 135 ft. over SW. slope.
