dist., mkd. ¼ S11 BT.

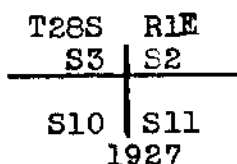
A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 59\* W., 39 lks.

60.00 Leave spur; slopes S. from NW.; asc. SE. slope.

68.40 Spur, slopes W.; 800 ft. above the ¼ sec. cor.  
Decs. 240 ft. over NW. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in  
the ground, for cor. to secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11,  
with brass cap, mkd.
