A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. $70\frac{1}{2}^*$ E., 34 lks.
dist., mkd. T28S R1E S2 CC BT.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S. $9\frac{1}{2}^*$ W., 20 lks.
dist., mkd. T28 S R1E S3 CC BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam; 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, cedar and hemlock.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron, chinquapin and
snowbrush.

From the cor. of Secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on S. bdy. of
Tp., previously described in field notes of T. 29 S.,
R. 1 E., this group.

N. 0^* 2' W., bet. secs. 33 and 34.

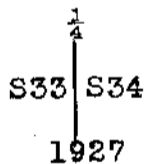
Desc. 85 ft. over broken NW. slope; through heavy green
timber and dense undergrowth.

23.75 Ravine, course W.; thence over broken W. slope.

31.50 Ravine, course SW.; asc. 50 ft. over SW. slope.

37.10 Spur, slopes SW., asc. 65 ft. over SW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in
the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.; with brass cap, mkd.

64.00 Ravine, course SW.; asc. 450 ft. over SE. slope.

the ground, for cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34,
with brass cap, mkd.
