dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S34 BT.

Desc. SW. slope.

- 42.15 Tiller to Quartz Mountain Trail, bears N. and S.
- 43.00 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course S.; 40 ft. below the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.; asc. 170 ft. over SE. slope.
- 63.70 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 45 ft. over SW. slope.
- 69.60 Ravine, course S.; asc. 125 ft. over SE. slope.
- 79.54 The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam; 3rd rate.

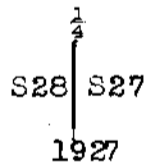
Timber, fir, pine and cedar.

- 35.80 Ravine, course E.; asc. 50 ft. over SE. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap, mkd.

A cedar, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 75\* W., 31 lks.  
dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$ S28 BT.

- 43.80 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 105 ft. over NE. slope.
- 47.75 Ravine, course E.; asc. 120 ft. over SE. slope to spur.
- 50.75 Tiller to Quartz Mountain Trail, bears NW. and SE.
- 59.25 Spur, slopes SE.; Tiller to Quartz Mountain Trail,
