N.89*63'E., on a random line bet. Secs. 15 and 22.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner.

80.20 Intersect N and S line, 21 lks. N of the cor. of
Secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23.

Thence

N.89*58'W on a true line bet. Secs. 15 and 22.

Descend 15 ft. over SW slope; through heavy green
timber and dense undergrowth.

5.50 Ravine, course S; ascend 600 ft. over E slope to divide.

18.25 Tiller to Quartz Mountain Trail, bears NE and S.

24.00 Divide bet. Quartz and Boulder Creeks, bears NW and SE.
Ascend 65 ft. over SE slope.

31.20 Spur, slopes S; descend 250 ft. over SW slope.

40.10 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in
