Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam; 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, cedar and hemlock.

Undergrowth, vine maple, chinquapin and rhododendron.

N. $89^* 58'$ E., on a random line bet. secs. 16 and 21.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

79.58 Intersect N. and S. line, 18 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22.

Thence

S. $89^* 50'$ W., on a true line bet. secs. 16 and 21.

Asc. 15 ft. over NE. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

0.60 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 80 ft. over NW. slope.

4.60 Head of ravine, course NW.; asc. 60 ft. over NE. slope.

10.50 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 250 ft. over NW. slope.

26.60 Spur, slopes N. 75^* W.; desc. 530 ft., over SW. slope.

39.79 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap, mkd.
