

Subdivision of T. 28 S., R. 1 E.

## CHAINS

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on S. bdy. of Tp., previously described in field notes of T. 29 S., R. 1 E., this group.

N. 0° 4' W., bet. secs. 31 and 32.

Desc. 515 ft. over NW. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

18.20 Ravine, course NW.; asc. 25 ft. over SW. slope.

20.60 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 175 ft. over NW. slope.

24.05 Ravine, course W.; asc. 125 ft. over SW. slope.

27.00 Spur, slopes S. 80° W.; desc. 145 ft. over NW. slope.

31.00 Ravine, course SW.; asc. 310 ft. over SW. slope.

40.00 Spur, slopes SW.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap, mkd.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 110 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S32 BT.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 40 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S31 BT.

Desc. 155 ft. over NW. slope.

47.35 Ravine, course W.; asc. 70 ft. over SW. slope.

51.50 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 315 ft. over NW. slope.

59.40 Ravine, course W.; asc. SW. slope.

60.50 Foot of impassable cliff, 200 ft. high, facing S., bears E. and W. To pass the cliff, I offset 1.80 chs. E., and then N. 0° 4' W., on the offset line.

64.20 Spur, slopes S. 75° W.; 235 ft. above ravine.

Desc. NW. slope and continue offset line to 66.60 chs; then W. 1.80 chs. to true line.

74.00 Ravine, course S. 75° W.; 480 ft. below spur; asc. 300 ft. over SW. slope.
