80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, with brass cap, mkd.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. $30\frac{1}{4}^*$ W., 44 lks. dist., mkd. T28S R1E S31 BT.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 56^* W., 75 lks. dist., mkd. T28S R1E S30 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam; 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, madrona and cedar.

Undergrowth, wine maple, chinquapin and manzanita.

East, on a random line bet. secs. 29 and 32.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

79.72 Intersect N. and S. line, 7 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.

Asc. 240 ft. over SE. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

6.00 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 285 ft. over SW. slope.
