48.70 Branch, 4 lks. wide, course NW.; asc. 30 ft. over NE. slope.

51.00 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 45 ft. over NW. slope.

54.90 Boulder Creek, 50 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. SE. slope.

57.90 Boulder Creek Way Trail, bears N. and S.

72.40 Spur, slopes S.; 370 ft. above Boulder Creek.

Descs. 145 ft. over SW. slope.

75.90 Ravine, course S.; asc. 25 ft. over SE. slope.

78.79 Spur, slopes S.

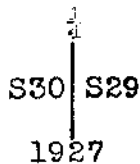
Asc. 455 ft. over SW. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap, mkd.
