

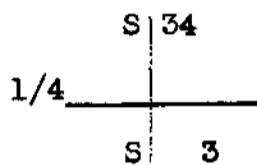

23.25 Dry bed of stream, 20 lks. wide, (apparently abandoned) course NE. turning to N., .2 chs. NE. of this point. Ascend 220 ft. to

35.00 Spur, slopes N.20*W. Descend 175 ft. over E. slope, to

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked

A douglas fir, 24 ins. dia., bears N.40*E., 34 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 34 B T

A sugar pine, 32 ins. dia., bears S.30*E., 25 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 3 BT

Descend 185 ft., over broken NE slope, to

41.25 Dry gulch, course NE., 30 feet below 1/4 sec. cor.

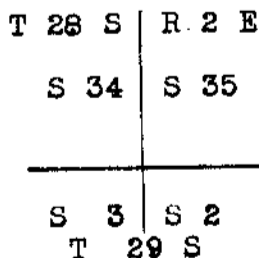
43.00 Low spur, slopes NE.

49.00 Foot of descent; dry bed of creek, 15 lks. wide, course N.30*W., ascend 150 ft. over W. slope to

60.40 Spur, slopes N. Descend 165 ft. over NE. slope.

71.60 Creek, 10 lks. wide, course NW. Ascend 115 ft. over SW slope to

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 2,3,34, and 35, with brass cap marked
