

East Boundary of T. 28 S. R. 2 E.

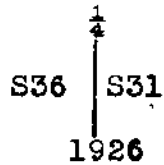
CHAINS

From the cor. of Tps. 28 and 29 S., Rs. 2 and 3 E.,  
previously described in field notes of T. 29 S.,  
R. 2 E., this group.

North, on a true line, bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over bottom land; through heavy green timber and  
dense undergrowth.

- 2.00 Bayou, 10 lks. wide, course NW.
- 5.80 Leave bottom land, bears NE. and SW., asc. 270 ft. over  
SE. slope to spur.
- 9.65 Trail, bears E. and W.
- 15.10 Spur, slopes SW., point of rock, 75 ft. high, 75 ft.  
diam., bears E., 1.00 ch. dist., to W. edge.,  
desc. 35 ft. over NW. slope.
- 19.00 Ravine, course SW., asc. 450 ft. over SE. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in  
the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



from which:

A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears S.36\*E., 56 lks. dist.  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 31 B T

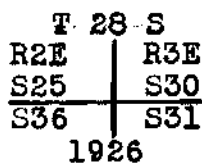
A pine, 24 ins. diam., bears N.75\*W., 18 lks. dist.  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 36 B T.

Spur, slopes SW.

Asc. 200 ft. over SW. slope.

- 62.70 Spur, slopes N.60\*W., trail, bears NW. and SE.,  
desc. 30 ft. over broken NE. slope.

- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in  
the ground, for cor. of secs. 25,30,31 and 36, with  
brass cap mkd.

A pine, 14 ins. diam., bears N.51 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*E., 50 lks.
