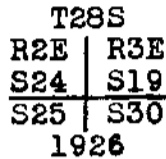


East Boundary of T. 28 S. R. 2 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, with brass cap mkd.

dist. mkd. T 28 S R 3 E S 19 B T

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.17\*E., 28 lks.  
dist. mkd. T 28 S R 3 E S 30 B T

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.33\*W., 58 lks.  
dist. mkd. T 28 S R 2 E S 25 B T.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.23\*W., 40 lks.  
dist. mkd. T 28 S R 2 E S 24 B T

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam, 3rd. and 4th rate.

Timber, fir, pine, hemlock and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple and rhododendron.

North, bet. secs. 19 and 24.

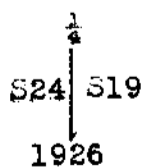
Asc. 100 ft. over broken SE. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

11.00 Spur, slopes SW., desc. 90 ft. over NW. slope.

18.35 Branch, 10 lks. wide, course SW., asc. 520 ft. over SE. slope to the 1/4 sec. cor.

32.35 Trail, bears NW. and SE,

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
