Land, mountainous

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam; 3rd. rate.

Timber; fir, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel and rhododendron.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Asc. 25 ft. over SW. slope; through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

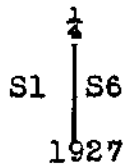
4.00 Spur, slopes W., desc. 160 ft. over N. slope.

9.00 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course NW., asc. 50 ft. over SW. slope.

11.35 Spur, slopes W., desc. 15 ft. over NW. slope.

12.30 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course W., asc. 385 ft. over SW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

44.00 Spur, slopes W., desc. 240 ft. over NW. slope.

62.00 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course SW., asc. 245 ft. over SE. slope.

73.88 Intersect the Sixth Standard Parallel South, 1.67 chs. W. from the cor. of Tps. 27 S., Rs. 1 and 2 E., previously described in field notes of T. 28 S., R. 1 E., this group.
